DECLARATION OF LAND PATENT-Amended

Land Patent No(s) 93224 issued by the office of the president of the United States of America stewarded by William H. Taft in the year one thousand nine hundred and nine; Land Patent No (s) 259 issued by the office of the president of the United States of America stewarded by William McKinley one thousand nine hundred; and,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENCE;

I, sam-germain, born in the family Betancour, said Betancour family having settled wihin the boundaries of bexar county at large,, San Antonio, San Antone, The First Municipal Government in Texas established in 1731, by Order of king Philip V of Spain, and the first Capitol of Texas, one hundred and eight years before Austin, forty five years before the United States Declaration of Independence was signed in 1776, one hundred and five years before the Battle of the Alamo in 1836, do declare that I bring forward Land Patents in my name, sam-germain. Property so sought to be brought forward, and lawfully inscribed and referenced with Patent Number(s) 93224, 259, and:

Starting with the northwest corner post of the split rail fence line, marked post number one with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh, abutting the northeast corner of the Izett family land to the west and abutting the southwest corner of the William J. Beck family land to the north, running north easterly along the south side of the gravel road, abutting the James Beck Jr. family land and the Northwood land along the north side of the road, north and east at sixty-two degrees forty-five minutes zero seconds, a distance of ninety one poles to the north central corner post marked number two, with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning south along the split rail fence, abutting the McNamara family land to the east, south and east at zero degrees eight minutes twenty six seconds, a distance of fifty seven point zero four poles to corner post marked number three with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning northeasterly along the split rail fence line, north and east at seventy two degrees seven minutes fifteen seconds, a distance of ten point forty five poles to

fence line post marked number four with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning north and east at fifty three degrees forty eight minutes zero seconds, a distance of two point twenty seven poles across the gravel road to fence post marked number five with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning north and east and along the south side of the gravel road, a distance of forty point seventy eight poles eventually crossing diagonally to a point on the north side of the gravel road one point eighty one poles north of corner post marked number six; at that point returning south and east at one degree four minutes zero seconds back to the south side of the gravel road, a distance of one point eighty one poles to fence line corner post marked number six with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning south and east at eight degrees eighteen minutes forty six seconds, a distance of four point ninety six poles to the end of the split rail fence line, continuing as a post and barbed wire fence line, a distance of sixteen point thirty three poles to fence post marked number seven with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning south and east at forty eight degrees forty six minutes fifty one seconds, a distance of forty one point fifty five poles to post marked number eight with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning south and east at zero degrees three minutes zero seconds, a distance of forty seven point six poles to fence line post marked number nine with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; turning along the ravine north and west at forty one degrees six minutes forty seconds, a distance of thirty nine point four poles to five eighths inch iron pin; moving along ravine north and west at seventy one degrees twenty nine minutes thirty five seconds, a distance of fifteen point twenty seven poles to five eighths inch iron pin; moving along ravine north and west at forty four degrees fifty minutes two seconds, a distance of fifteen point ninety poles to five eighths inch iron pin; moving along ravine south and west at ninety degrees zero minutes zero seconds, a distance of seven point ninety five poles back to three rail fence line road corner post at the east side of gravel road marked number ten with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh; moving across the gravel road south and west at ninety degrees zero minutes zero seconds to three rail fence line road corner post marked number eleven with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh, at south at twenty eight degrees thirty minutes two seconds east, a distance of zero point ninety eight poles; moving south and west at ninety degrees zero minutes zero seconds along split rail fence line to post marked number twelve with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh, a distance of twenty point zero four poles; turning south and east at zero degrees eight minutes six seconds along barbed wire fence line a distance of sixty two point sixty seven poles to corner post marked number thirteen with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh and a five eighths inch iron pin at south at two degrees fifty six minutes thirteen seconds west; turning westerly along the southern boundary barbed wire fence line to post marked number fourteen with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh and a five eighths inch iron pin a distance of eighty point forty six poles; continuing to move along southern boundary barbed wire fence line to southwest corner post marked number fifteen with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh and a Doyle rebar iron pin at south at seventy two degrees nine minutes twenty six seconds west, a distance of eighty point forty four poles; turning northerly along the western boundary barbed wire fence line north and west at zero degrees forty six minutes forty four seconds to northwest corner post of pasture marked number sixteen with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh and a Doyle rebar iron pin at south at eighty nine degrees eleven minutes one second west a distance of eighty point zero five poles ; turning easterly

along split rail fence line north and east at eighty nine degrees forty six minutes forty nine seconds to west central corner post marked number seventeen with the stewards family crest and the name of yahweh and a Doyle rebar iron pin at south at eighty nine degrees fifteen minutes nine seconds west, a distance of eighty point forty six poles; turning north along the split rail fence line a distance of seventy two point twenty seven poles back to the starting point, to have and to hold in the name of yahweh, and

Within the boundary of the first judicial district of tens, The boundary lines of the first judicial district of tens are inscribed as follows; Beginning at a point on the International boundary line where the line between the ranges 21 and 20W intersects said boundary; thence south along west line of Range 20 to the Flathead river; thence north along the right bank of the Flathead river to where the south line of sec. 18 Twp 30 n Range 20 w intersects said river; thence east to the base of the Kootenai Mountains; thence northerly along the base of said Mountains to a point 1/2 mile south from the Flathead river; thence east to the South Fork; thence in a South East direction along the left bank of South Fork to the eastern boundary of Flathead County; thence north on the county line to the North East corner of the county; thence west on northern boundary of the county Flathead to the place of the beginning December 15, 1906-North 1/2 North West 1/4 Section 22, Town 30, Range 20. Commencing at Bad Rock Canyon at the mouth of the South Fork of Flathead River; thence up the south fork to the east boundary line of the county flathead; thence northerly along said line to the International Boundary line; thence west along said line to a point directly north of the North East Corner of Section 12, Twp. 29N. Range 21 west; thence south to said corner; thence east to the Flathead river; thence up the west bank of said river to the Bad Rock Canyon and place of beginning, and

Within, from and after the first day of March eighteen ninety three, that all that portion of the Montana republic embraced within the following boundaries shall be known as and shall be Flathead County, in the Montana republic, to-wit: Commencing on the forty-ninth parallel of latitude at a point where the same is intersected by the summit of the main range of the Rocky Mountains, thence in a southerly direction following the summit of said mountains to a point where the same meets and is intersected by the eastern boundary line of Missoula County; thence south along said boundary line to latitude forty-seven degrees and thirty-five minutes, thence west along said line of latitude to meridian one hundred and fourteen degrees and thirty-five minutes west, thence north along said meridian to the sixth standard parallel, thence west and along said parallel to meridian one hundred and fifteen degrees west, thence north along said meridian to the forty-eighth parallel of latitude, thence west along said parallel to a point where the same is intersected by the summit of the divide or watershed between the Kootenai and Clark's Fork of the Columbia Rivers, the same being known as the Cabinet range of mountains, thence in a northwesterly direction following the summit of said divide or watershed to the eastern boundary line of the State of Idaho, thence north along said Idaho line to the forty-ninth parallel of latitude, thence east along said parallel to the place of beginning, and

Within, from and after the seventeenth day of August eighteen eighty nine, the boundaries of the Montana republic shall be as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of the twenty-seventh degree of longitude west from Washington republic with the forty-fifth degree of north latitude, thence due west on the forty-fifth degree of latitude to a point formed by its intersection with the thirty-fourth degree of longitude west from Washington republic, thence due south along the thirty-fourth degree of longitude, to a point formed by its intersection with the crest of the Rocky Mountains, thence following the crest of the Rocky Mountains northward to its intersection with the Bitter Root Mountains; thence northward along the crest of the Bitter Root Mountains, to its intersection with the thirty-ninth degree of longitude west from Washington republic; thence along the thirty-ninth degree of longitude northward to the boundary line of the British Possessions; thence eastward along that boundary line to the twenty-seventh degree of longitude west from Washington republic; thence southward along the twenty-seventh degree of longitude to the place of beginning, and

Within the boundary of The United States of America inscribed as follows;

The United States of America

The United States of America was founded in the year 1776 along the east coast of North America, wedged between British Canada and Spanish Mexico. The original country consisted of thirteen states and territory that extended west to the Mississippi River. Since the year 1776, a variety of treaties, purchases, wars, and Acts of Congress have extended the territory of The United States of America to what we know today, and

The government of the United States Senate, the upper house of Congress approves treaties between The United States of America and other countries, and However, boundary changes of states that lie on international borders require the approval of the state legislature in that state. Boundary changes between states require the approval of each state's legislature and the approval of Congress. The one supreme court of The United States of America settles boundary disputes between states, and

By and between the years 1782-1783: Treaties with the United Kingdom established the government of the United States, the government of the United States of the United States of America, the government of the United States of America, and left the forty-eight republics as separate countries in Union, which established the boundary of The United States of America as being bound on the north by Canada, on the south by Spanish Florida, on the west by the Mississippi River, and on the east by the Atlantic Ocean, and

In the year 1803: The Louisiana Purchase extends the western boundary of The United

States of America to the Rocky Mountains, occupying the drainage area of the Mississippi River, as estimated by the French explorer Robert La Salle. The Purchase doubled the territory of The United States of America, and

In the year 1818: A convention with the United Kingdom established the northern boundary of the Louisiana Purchase at 49 degrees north. In the year 1819: Florida was ceded to The United States of America and purchased from Spain, and

In the year 1820; Maine became a republic, carved out of the state of Massachusetts. The northern boundary of Maine was disputed between the U.S. and Canada so the King of the Netherlands was brought in as an arbiter and he settled the dispute in 1829. However, Maine refused the deal and since Congress requires the approval of a state legislature for boundary changes, the Senate could not approve a treaty over the border. Ultimately, in the year 1842 a treaty established the Maine-Canada border of today although it provided Maine with less territory than the King's plan would have, and

In the year 1845; the independent Republic of Texas by and between the years 1836-1845 was annexed to the United States. The territory of Texas extended north at 42 degrees north into modern Wyoming due to a secret treaty between Mexico and Texas, and

In the year 1846; Oregon Territory is ceded to the U.S. from Britain following an 1818 joint claim on the territory which resulted in the phrase "Fifty-Four Forty or Fight!" The Treaty of Oregon establishes the boundary at 49 degrees north, and

In the year 1848; The Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo following the Mexican War between the U.S. and Mexico resulted in the purchase of Arizona, California, Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, Utah, and western Colorado republics, and

In the year 1853; With the Gadsden Purchase of 1853, the land acquisition that resulted in the area of the 48 contiguous republics today was completed. Southern Arizona and southern New Mexico were purchased for \$10 million and named for the United States minister to Mexico, James Gadsden, and

By and between the years 1862-1863; when Virginia decided to secede from the Union at the start of the Civil War by and between the years 1861-1865, the western counties of Virginia voted against the secession and decided to form their own republic. West Virginia was established with help from Congress, who approved of the new republic on December 31, 1862 and West Virginia was admitted to the Union on June 19, 1863. West Virginia was originally going to be called Kanawha, and

In the year 1867; Alaska was purchased from Russia for \$7.2 million in gold. Some thought the idea was ridiculous and the purchase became known as Seward's Folly, after Secretary of State William Henry Seward. The boundary between Russia and Canada was established by treaty in 1825, and

In the year 1898; Hawaii was annexed into the United States, and

In the year 1925; The final treaty with the United Kingdom clarifies the boundary through the Lake of the Woods Minnesota, resulting in the transfer of a few acres between the two countries, and

Within the republic territorial seaward boundaries of The United States of America, beyond the baseline inscribed as follows, and

On the east coast inscribed as the Atlantic Ocean, twelve nautical miles beyond the baseline, abutting the contiguous zone, furthermore, abutting the exclusive economic zone the high seas, and the territorial sea boundaries of the United States, and

On the west coast inscribed as the Pacific Ocean, twelve nautical miles beyond the baseline, abutting the contiguous zone, furthermore, abutting the exclusive economic zone, the high seas and the territorial sea boundaries of the United States, and

On the Gulf Coast inscribed as the Gulf of Mexico, twelve nautical miles beyond the baseline, abutting the contiguous zone, furthermore, abutting the exclusive economic zone, the high seas and the territorial sea boundaries of the United States, and

No claim is made herein that sam-germain has been assigned the entire tracks of land inscribed in the original Patents. The assignment is inclusive only written in the above lawful inscription. FURTHERMORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ESTABLISHED BY THE NEW COVENANT, that, I, sam-germain, steward for the great office of the assignee, in law, and bonafide subsequent purchaser by contract, of that certain lawfully inscribed portion of Land Granted under Original Land Patent Number(s) 93224 and 259, duly authorized to be executed in the Supremacy of Genesis, chapter forty seven Mathew, chapters five through seven, Matthew, seventeen verses twenty-four through twenty-six, Genesis, chapter one and two, Daniel, chapter four verse three, as obeyed and agreed upon written in the Treaty of Paris, in the year seventeen-hundred and eighty three, Citations and Constitutional mandates, herein referenced, whereupon a duly authenticated true and correct lawful inscription of a sweat equity chattel deed for which is appended hereto,

A common courtesy of sixty (60) days is offered for any claims hereto, otherwise, latches/ estoppels shall forever bar the same against said allodium title in the name of my Sovereign, yahweh, as the supreme authority for the land patent; all warranties express or implied are in the hands of the Allodium Title holder, yahweh.

The document is instructed to be attached to all deeds and/or conveyances in the name(s) of the steward(s) below shown as requiring recording of the document in a manner known as nunc pro tunc, as it should have been done in the beginning, non-negotiable, immovable.

It is hereby established by the word, that, I, sam-germain, do declare that I hold the great office of assignee/steward to manage my part of the land patents; 93224 and 259, a copy of which is attached hereto. I further declare that, by the authority of yahshua, the Anointed One, manage the great office of assignee in the name of yahweh, in the judicial district of tens, and said office is attached and assigned to manage a portion of said land patents which is lawfully inscribed within the attachments hereto and made a part hereof.

No claim is made herein that neither I, nor my office has been assigned the entire tract of land as inscribed in the original patents. The assignment is inclusive of only the attached lawful inscription. The filing of the declaration of Land Patents shall not deny or infringe on any right, privilege, or immunity of any other office of assignee or assignee to any other portion of land covered in the above inscribed patent numbers, and

If the land patent is not challenged by a qualified claim under exclusive and original

jurisdiction of a district court of the United republics within sixty (60) days from the day of filing, then the above inscribed properties shall be mine to steward in the name of my Sovereign, yahweh.

Furthermore, the land patent shall be in the condition precedent of nihil dicit, and is therefore been absolutely brought forward in my name, sam germain, to have and to hold in the name of yahweh, and as promised by yahweh, to pass on to my heirs, future assignments and callings forever, and,
